

Paying your fees by International Bank Transfer



You should read the information on this page before completing an international bank transfer.

Bradford College has partnered with PaytoStudy as its preferred payment option. PaytoStudy is a service that allows students (or those paying on their behalf) to create an account and settle their fees in their local currency.

What you need

- To have been offered and accepted a place at Bradford College
- A valid Bradford College student number
- Details of the fees you wish to pay
- The ability to scan your payment receipt and a copy of your National ID (passport / driving licence)

How does it work?

- 1) Go to <https://bradfordcollege.paytostudy.com>, complete the registration details and then enter the amounts in GBP that you wish to transfer. The amount in your local currency will be displayed on screen along with the exchange rate used. This should be a competitive exchange rate and therefore result in a lower cost to you in your local currency.
Note: Not all currencies are available and therefore an alternative currency will be offered (Euros or US Dollars).
- 2) Complete the payment transaction by either printing the confirmation advice and taking it to your local bank or complete an online bank transfer (if you have access to online banking) in your local currency to the bank details provided on the confirmation advice.
- 3) Scan receipt of your payment and email it to confirm@paytostudy.com.
- 4) Payment confirmation will be emailed to you.

Advantages of this Service

This service offers many advantages to students and the College. These are:

- Students can pay their fees in local currency (where an account is available)
- PaytoStudy do not charge for this service
- Competitive exchange rates (should be better than your bank or card issuer's rates)
- Payment can be tracked online with a 24 hour dedicated customer service centre
