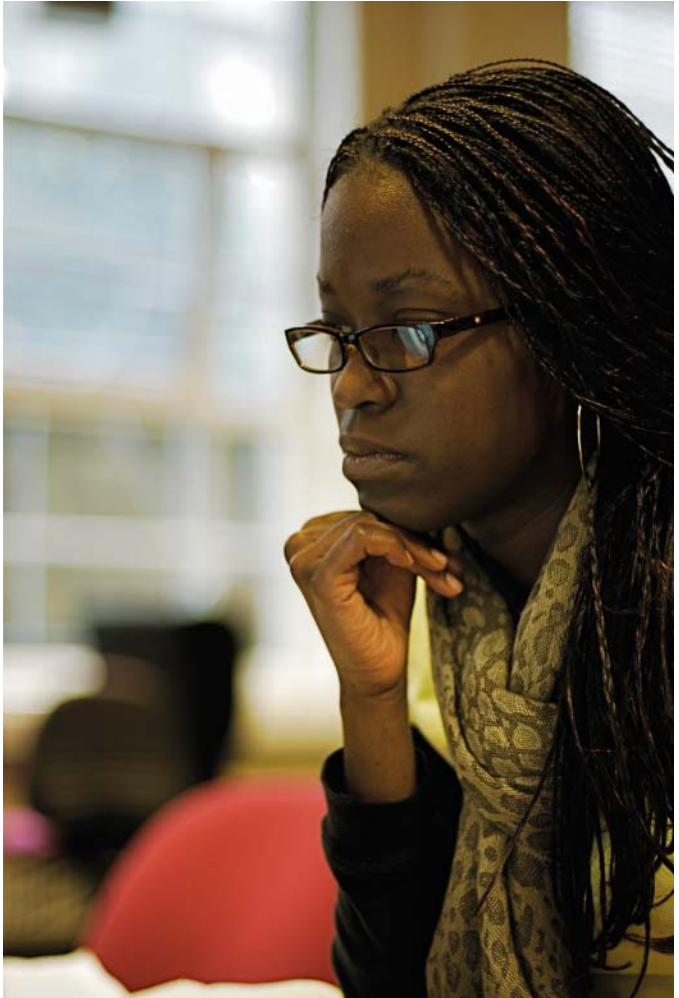

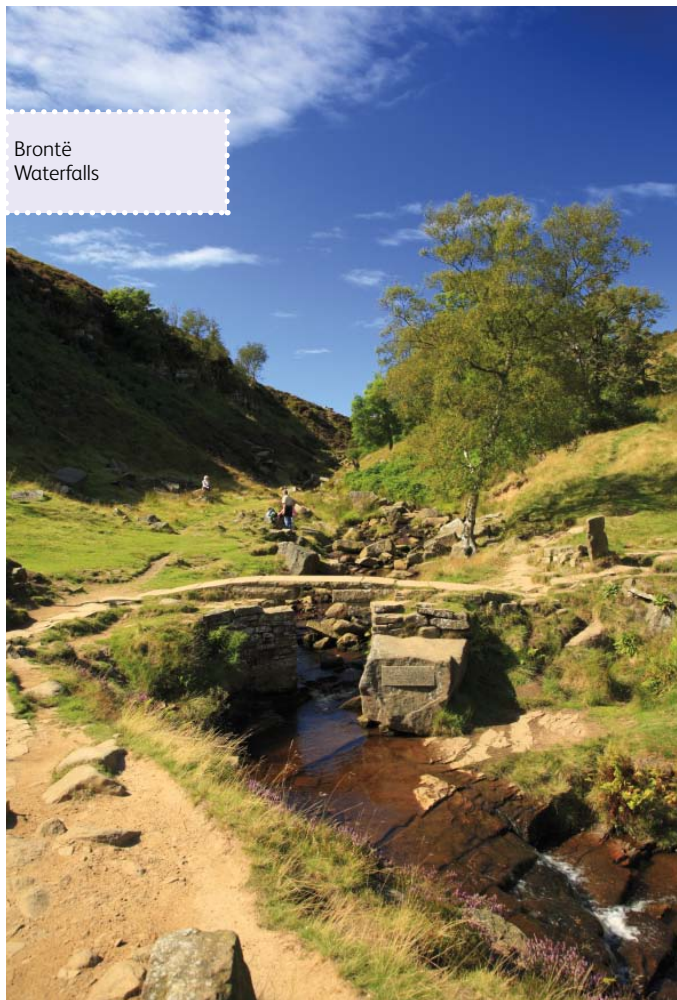


## Surprise, surprise

## Getting here by air

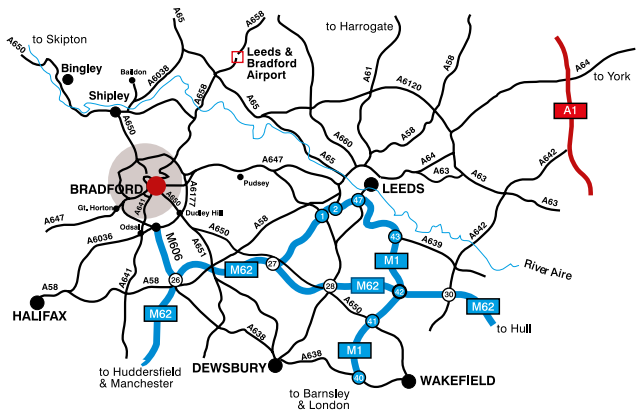
Bradford is centrally located in the UK and has easy access to road, rail, air and sea routes. It's two train stations and coach station deliver good services to towns and cities within the UK.
