Bradford College – 16 -19 Tuition Fund Plan

The college has had in the region of 1, 000 students who have been impacted by COVID-19 by either loss of learning, delayed assessment or lack of access to assessment.

To ensure every learner affected has the chance to progress and achieve their aspirations, the college will provide support to affected students through small group tuition for English, maths, and other vocational courses where learning has been disrupted by providing:

- Additional tuition time
- Portfolio or assessment support
- Additional vocational practice and workshop time
- Additional assessment opportunity
- FastTrack learning and ability to undertake resits where applicable
- Additional Success centre time (English and maths)
- Additional support for those whose grades have been severely affected
- Additional time for attending and completing work experience linked to the vocational course
- Additional one to one support time for SEND students who have not been able to access college or online learning in the past 6 months

Each students development needs are assessed to determine what will be most effective for the student and the resources needed will come from:

- Additional classes
- Additional hours for existing staff
- Hire of additional workshop space where requirement for assessment
- Relief/ supply staff
- Additional staff for Success Centres
- Additional recruitment of new teachers
- Third party support particularly with SEND students

Support is provided to learners in a mixture of group and 1:1 sessions and are delivered flexibility to meet specific needs.
