Arrangements for obtaining the views of students and staff

The Instrument & Articles of Governance of the College require the publication of arrangements for consulting with students and staff at the College on the determination and periodic review of the educational character and mission of the College and the oversight of its activities.

The views of students and staff are vital to shaping the College's strategy and approach. Feedback from students feeds into the College's quality assurance and review procedures, including the Self-Assessment Report and the Quality Improvement Plan. Equally, the College values the views and opinions of staff as part of its decision making and quality assurance process.
