16-18 Bursary Meals

16-19 Bursary / Learner Support Fund

If your household income is £50,000 or less, you could be eligible for support with travel costs, meals on the days you are in College and help with course-related costs such as uniform, stationery, course trips etc.

Bradford College has been offering Apprenticeships for over thirty years, working closely with employers within Bradford and the wider Leeds region.





STUDY ROUTES

Full-time education

- » Study at College most days of the week
- » You will receive a timetable once vou have enrolled

Apprenticeships

- » Study at College 1 day a week
- » Work placement/experience minimum 30 hours per week

T Levels

- » Study at College 4 days a week
- » 1 day in a work placement.
- » You will work a minimum of 315 hours (45 days). For our Education and Early Years and T Levels, you must work 750 hours (100 days).

Entry requirements

Here is a useful guide to where you will start, depending on your GCSE grade results:

- NO FORMAL QUALIFICATIONS Entry Level 3.
- **GRADES 1-2 IN GCSEs** You will be able to study all our **Level 1 courses**. English and/or Maths will be included in your timetable if you do not have the grades.
- GRADES 3 IN GCSEs You will be able to study our **Level 2 courses**, Foundation T Level and Level 2 Apprenticeships. English and/or Maths will be included in your timetable if you do not have the grades.
- GRADES 4-9 IN GCSEs INCLUDING ENGLISH AND MATHS

You will be able to study our **Level 3** courses, T Levels and some Level 3 Apprenticeships.

Some of our technical courses that require skills not learnt at school will start at a Level 1 or 2, no matter what your GCSEs grades are. We will take you through this when you come for your interview.
