Work experience is required to earn your T Level Qualification and license to practice. You will have a mentor at your placement, and in college, you'll attend weekly workshops with a Placement Assessor who will support your skill development and observe you at work.

Progression

After completing this T Level, you'll be ready to pursue:

- Roles such as Teaching Assistant, Early Years Practitioner, or Primary Teaching.

Successful completion of your T Level qualification allows you to be employed as a Level 3 Educator within Early Years and Nursery School Settings, and is your full licence to practice. Your T Level is equivalent to 3 A-levels and will be graded from Pass to Distinction Star.
