Develop your creative voice with our UAL Level 3 Diploma and Extended Diploma in Creative Practice. producing a 3D piece. Throughout the course you'll learn how to analyse visual language, respond to briefs, and present your work professionally.

As the course progresses, you'll refine technical skills and build a portfolio that reflects your individuality and ambition.
