Entry Requirements

Entry requirements are GCSE English at Grade 3 and GCSE Maths at Grade 2 or above

You'll attend a two-day assessment, which includes tests in Maths and English, a physical assessment, and an evaluation of your self-discipline. If you haven't achieved a grade 3 or higher in GCSE English or Maths, these subjects will be included in your timetable.

We also welcome applications from mature students who can show us they have the necessary skills and experience to succeed on the course.

You'll need to buy and wear a uniform, and there will be compulsory trips that you'll have to pay for. Additionally, you'll need to pay £60 for travel during outdoor activities, and you must have a pair of walking boots. Waterproof clothing is recommended for your comfort.
