Disclosure and Barring Service Policy for Students and Staff

Purpose of the Policy

The purpose of the policy is to ensure that staff, students and others who have regular and unsupervised access to children or vulnerable adults in the course of work, learning or other College activity, are safe to do so.

The College will:

- Carry out a DBS check on ALL applicants, students, staff and others who, as part of their learning or work with College, engage in any regulated activity with children (under 18) or vulnerable adults.
- Provide DBS application guidelines to those who are subject to DBS checks.
- Investigate any disclosure of a relevant conviction in the course of the DBS process.
- Treat all applicants equally, fairly and consistently; ensuring that any decision to qualify or withdraw an offer of a place or employment is reasonable and necessary for the protection of children or vulnerable adults.
- Provide appropriate staff development for all staff.
- Ensure that the procedures are transparent, reliable, valid, inclusive and underpinned by appropriate organisational structures and processes.
- Manage the collection, storage and retention of DBS data in accordance with GDPR regulations.
