DISCOVER@BradfordCollege is our online search tool and is a quick and easy way to search all the College Library's resources, print and electronic, and find full text information. You can search for books, e-books, and journal articles.

DISCOVER is a bit like using Google but the results are higher quality and more relevant to your course at Bradford College. If you are looking for information for an assignment DISCOVER is a great place to start. It's as easy as 1, 2, 3 ...

1 Enter your search terms. You can also edit or re-run your previous searches.

2 Too many results? The **Left Column** displays Limiters and Facets. You can refine your search by date of publication, source type, subject or content provider for example.

3 The **Middle Column** displays the results of your search including books, e-books and journal articles. View the full text of journal articles by clicking on the PDF or HTML link.

4 The **Right Column** displays the BBC News feed and also links to additional library resources which are not included in DISCOVER.

5 Create a personal account to save your results and create Search Alerts and RSS feeds.
